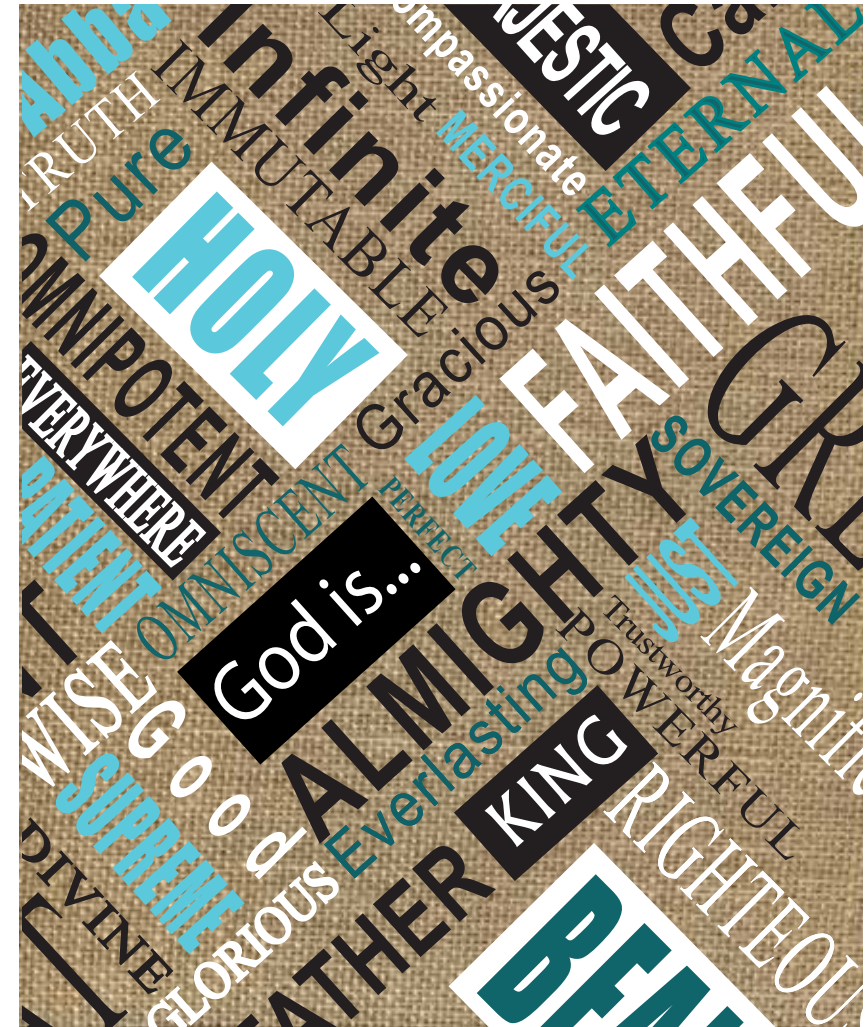
Faith & Film Night: Our youth Faith & Film Night has been changed. It will now be held on Friday, October 17, in the Youth Center from 6:00-9:00pm.
