Year-end Contribution Policy

In order to be in compliance with the Internal Revenue Service, any contributions which donors wish to be reported as 2017 deductible contributions must meet the following criteria:

1. If delivered in person, contributions must be received in the church business office no later than 3:00 p.m. Friday, December 29 or turned in on Sunday, December 31.
2. If the contribution is mailed, it must be postmarked (not meter-dated) no later than December 31, 2017.
3. If the contribution is electronically sent, the sending date must be no later than December 31, 2017.

Any gift received on January 1, 2018 or later will be shown as a 2018 contribution. IRS guidelines require that members who wish to itemize contribution deductions must have a copy of the church's contribution report when filing an income tax return. Reports will be mailed in January 2018.
