Nominations will be received June 1-July 31, 2014.

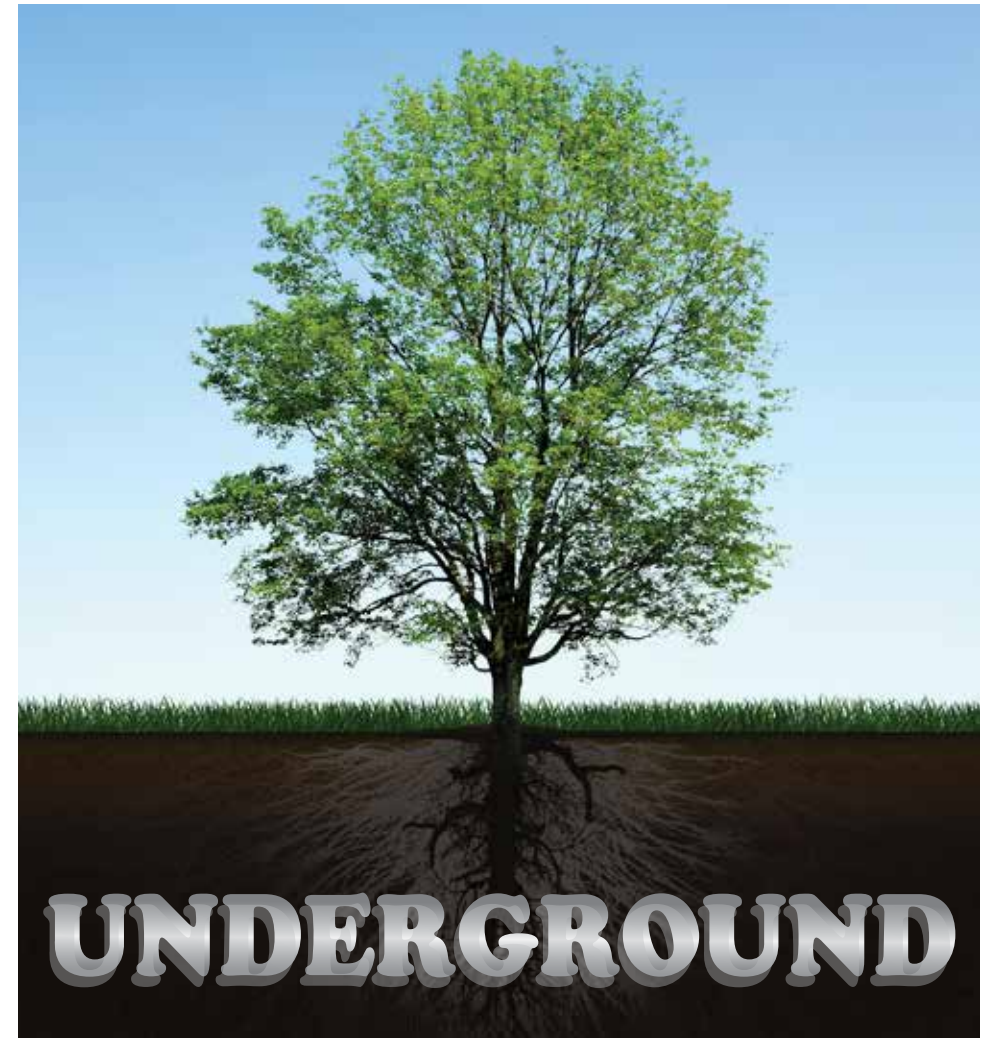
