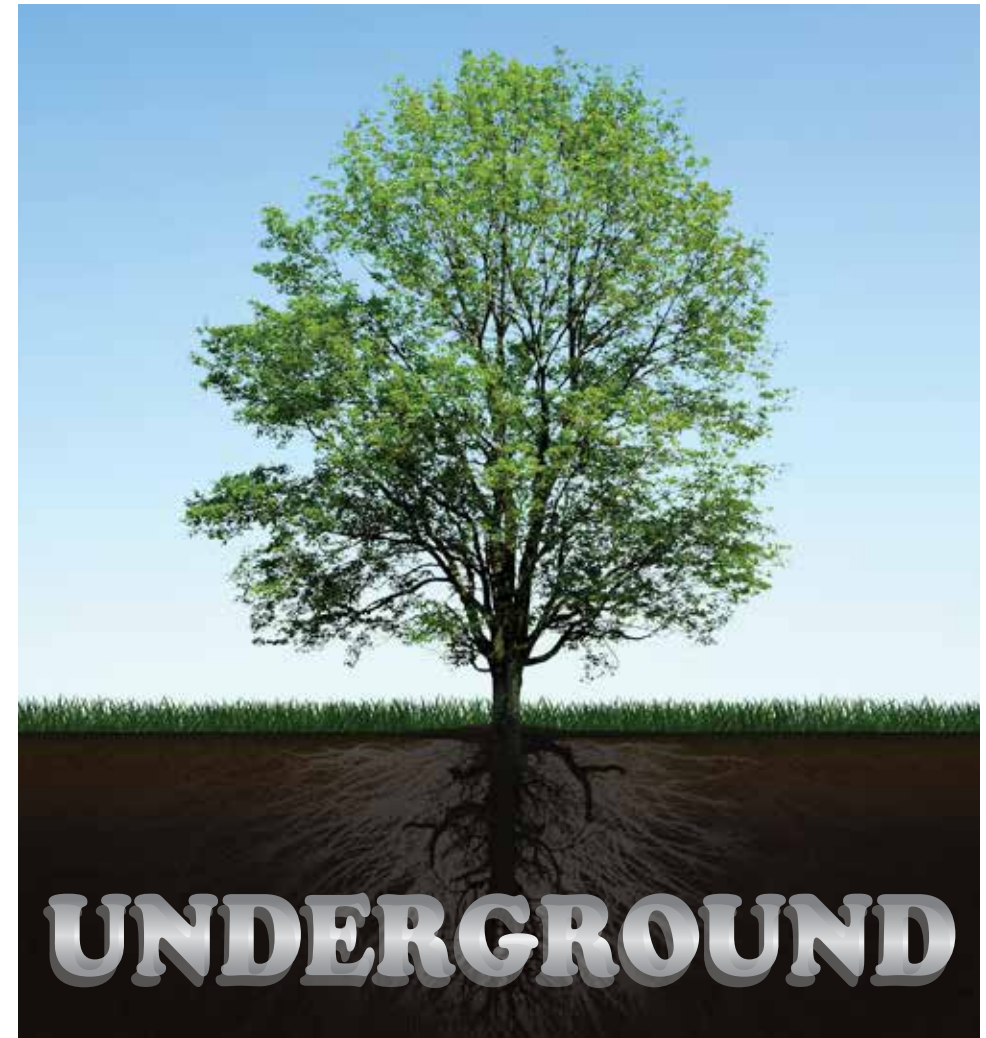
Labor Day: The church office will be closed Monday, September 1, for Labor Day
